Humanities (Arts Faculty)
B. A. Part I (NEP 2020)

The students shall be offered admission to B. A. Part I (NEP 2020) course satisfying the following eligibility criterion:

Eligibility: Students passing HSC examination with History, Economics, Social Science etc.
OR Students passing HSC examination (MCVC stream) with Arts subjects Based Group.

Available choice of Major/Minor Subjects: Marathi, MLT, ELT, English, Political Science, Economics, Home Economics, Philosophy yoga, Functional English, Music.

Admission Seats: 360+120 seats. These seats will be filled as per the reservation policy prescribed by Government of Maharashtra.

Note:

- From the choice of the available subjects, students have to choose one subject as 'Major' and another subject as 'Minor' from the same group.
- The combination of Major/Minor subjects will be fixed till Semester VI.
- Classes will be conducted in accordance with the SEMESTER PATTERN as prescribed by the university.
- Medium of instruction for all the groups is ENGLISH and MARATHI
- As per the Directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, The subject Environmental Science [EVS] is compulsory for B.A., B.Com & B. Sc. Part TWO Students.
- Apart from Major/Minor Subjects, students from both the groups have to study following subjects also:

Generic/Open Elective Course (G/OEC) Theory 1 (to be chosen from other faculty)	Generic/Open Elective Course (G/OEC) Theory 2 (to be chosen from other faculty)

10. Regular students may confirm their admissions to next classes within fifteen from the date of the result/s.

12. Admission Fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances if the candidate cancels his/her admission.

14. Principal in his discretionary power may amend admission rules. His decision shall stand final.

(A) Students having the age of 26 years, (B) Differently-abled Students. [A differently-abled student to not to attend the physical training/classes is required to produce a medical certificate from the competent medical authority.] They must also seek the certificate of exemption from principal by 10th of January every year and attach it with their University Admission Form Students' Attendance.
- As per university and government rules and regulations, no student should have his/her classes attendance below 75-percent. Attendance below 75-percent may not allow a student to write university examination.

IMPORTANT NOTE

- College is opening on 18 June, 2026. Part I & II students awaiting their university results and are about to confirm their admission in Parts II and III are hereby informed that to attend the classes from 01 July, 2026.
- Students cannot display any bills, advertisements, notices, etc of any kind on college premises without prior permission of the college principal.

ANTI-MOBILE USAGE-ACT

Using mobile phones on campus is strictly prohibited. This prohibition is in accordance with 'Anti-Mobile Phone Act.' Students found using mobile phones on the campus will be imposed with a fine of Rs. 1000/-.

ANTI-RAGGING CIRCULAR

Action Against Ragging: Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act XXXIII of 1999 with effect from May 15, 1999 has following provisions for Action Against Ragging.

- (A) Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.
- (B) Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participate in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to TWO YEARS and/or penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

- (C) Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of the order of such dismissal.
- (D) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of an educational institution complains in writing of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of the educational institution shall without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry, by head of the educational institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received, he/she will intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of the educational institution shall be final.
- (E) If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in the section “D” above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section “B” above.

Code of conduct for students (2026-2027)

01. Students shall enter college campus/premises in college approved uniforms.
02. Students are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline inside college campus.
03. Students are expected to remain present in classrooms well in time.
04. No student shall enter or leave the classroom without prior permission of the teaching faculty.

05. Students shall keep the campus neat and clean. They will not throw dirt/garbage anywhere on the campus. They will use dustbins.
06. Misconduct/Misbehavior/ Unwanted gestures towards girl students, violent commotions or threats of any kind to anyone else on college campus/premises shall be taken up as grave conduct on the part of the student/s.
07. Physical or verbal abuse of the other based on his/her gender, caste, creed, color, religion, religious beliefs, language, differently-abled status, sexual orientation, marital or family status are serious criminal/punishable offence.
08. Harassing or ill-treating, or ragging junior students/classmates/batch-mates (both boys and girls) shall be considered a criminal offence as per the directives of the government of Maharashtra and the Hon. Supreme Court of India.
09. After college teaching-learning hours are over, no students shall loiter or gather across veranda of the college building. Everyone is required to quit the college premises as immediately as possible.
